SYMPOSIUM THANK RECAP YOU!






Executive Spatight Students! Meet Ledia

Hello pre-vet students!

My name is Ledia, and I'm going into my third year of Animal Biology at the University of Guelph. I currently serve as the Junior Vice President of Merchandise for the CPVMA. In this role, I work alongside the Senior VP of Merchandise to design our CPVMA merch and help manage our Shopify storefront!

When it comes to animals, I'd say my favorites are cats. I actually had the chance to work at a cat cafe during my first year, which was such a cool experience! Not only did I get to learn more about cat behavior and socialization, but I also learned how adoption processes work, since the cats were adoptable through a local shelter partnership. It was a great opportunity to work with both animals and people, as I communicated with customers and coworkers regularly.

I'm still exploring my veterinary interests and trying to learn more about the different specializations within the field. I recently completed a nutrition course in my second year and found it super interesting, which inspired me to register for more nutrition-based courses in my third year—like wildlife and fish nutrition. I'm also looking forward to courses like genetics of companion animals and animal disorders, which I think will help me figure out what I'm most passionate about.



One piece of advice I'd give to other pre-vet students is to start early when looking for shadowing or volunteer opportunities. I began my search for summer placements during the fall semester and aimed to send out my first round of emails by January. Not every place will respond, so it's helpful to have a few alternatives lined up. Putting yourself out there early can really make a difference!

Article of the Month

This month's article focuses on a serious but often misunderstood issue: feline aggression toward owners. Though cat bites and scratches are reported less often than dog bites, they can result in significant injuries—especially to vulnerable individuals—and often lead to a breakdown in the human-animal bond. The article outlines common causes, including fear, overstimulation during petting, redirected aggression, and rough play. It emphasizes that punishment is not effective and often makes the problem worse. Instead, a structured treatment plan is recommended, involving trigger avoidance, environmental enrichment, behavior modification, and—when needed—medication.






