



Article of the Month

This month's feature highlights Dr. Shane Bateman, a University of Guelph veterinarian leading the way in forensic veterinary science. One of the few in Canada with formal training in the field, Dr. Bateman is using his expertise to investigate animal abuse cases and train the next generation of vets to recognize and respond to signs of cruelty. His work bridges clinical care and legal accountability—especially in cases where animal abuse overlaps with domestic violence—and reflects a growing shift toward the veterinarian's role in justice and advocacy.


